The maximum number of participants is twenty.

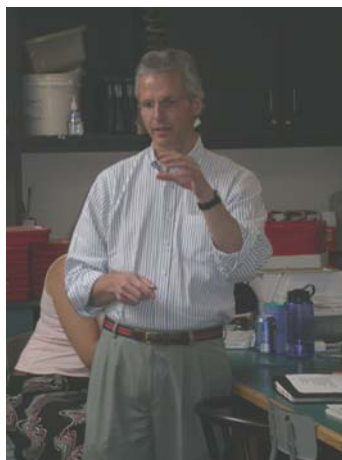
