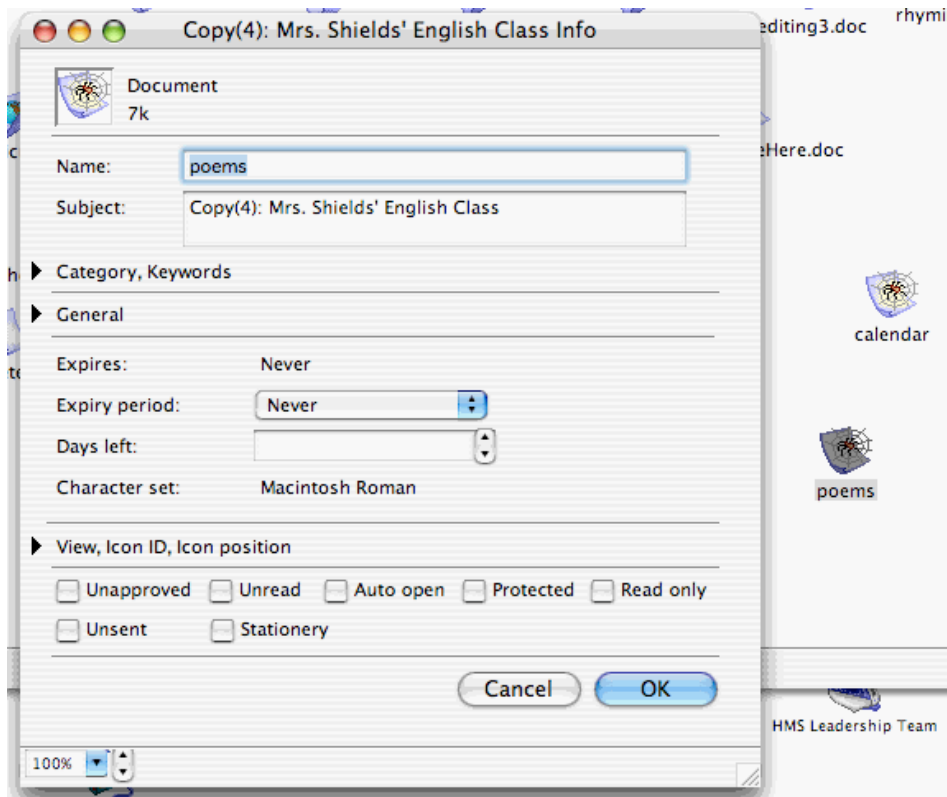


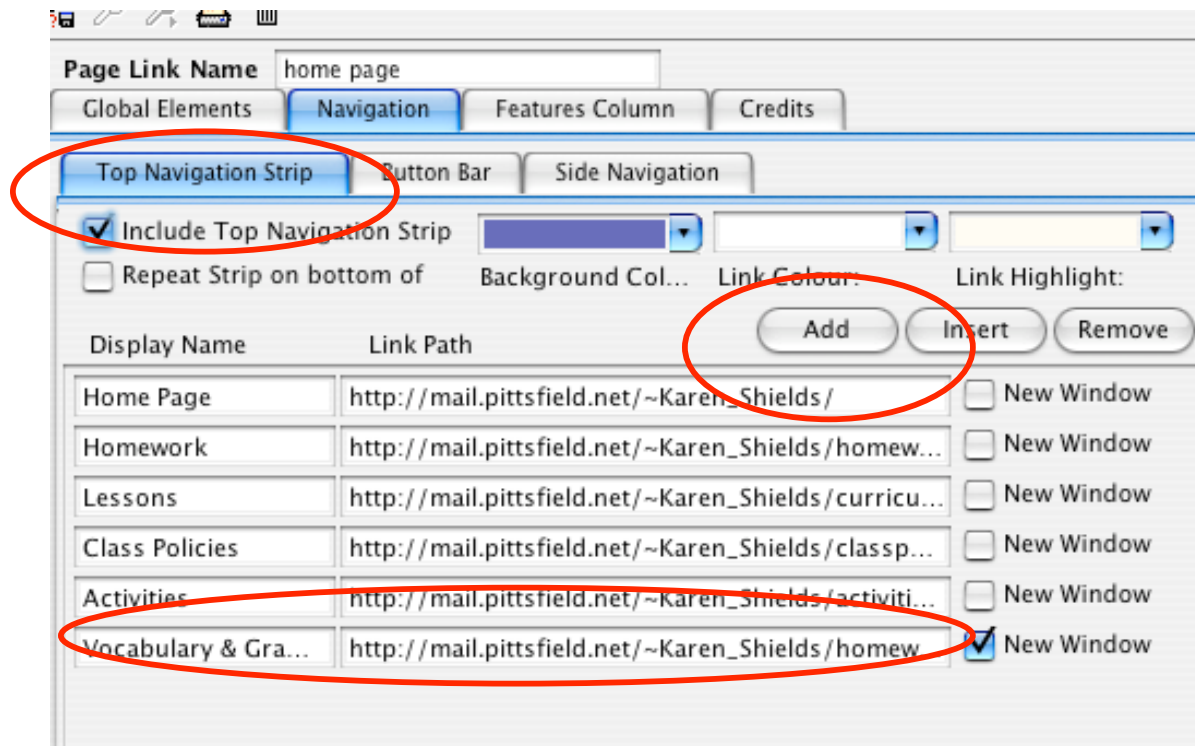
Creating a second page on your First Class website:

1. To copy your home page (or any web page), hold down the Option key first, then drag the page to the right or left and let go. It will duplicate itself.
2. Then rename the page. Do this by highlighting the new page, then clicking Apple and "i" together. An "information" box will appear, where you can type the new page's name.
3. Type the new name of the page (math, reading) in the "Name" box. (see next page)



4. The page will look exactly like the page you copied – it's just a copy! Give it a new headline right away and add new links and information, etc. to make it different.

5. The last step is to link the new page to your home page. Go to Navigation, Top Strip in your First Class home page ... click "Add" and enter the name of the new page in the link path and the "display name."



6. That's it! You have a new page and can make it look completely different if you want. Repeat the process for each type of class you have, or for different lessons, each page with its own set of links, pictures, attached documents, etc.
